Key Components of the Future Parks and Open Space

The Lansdowne parks and open space will comprise four main physical areas:

- A civic plaza
- A linear park
- A centre park
- A neighbourhood plaza

The size, location, configuration and objectives of these areas were established through a multi-phased Official Community Plan/City Centre Area Plan (OCP/CCAP) amendment process which included public engagement throughout. **The OCP/CCAP amendment was adopted by Council on November 27, 2023. Civic Plaza

Location: Adjacent to the Lansdowne Canada Line Station.

Size: Approximately 0.61 hectares (1.5 acres), which is similar in size to a soccer field or 13 basketball courts.

Objective: To be a welcoming, well-serviced town square for civic celebrations and events, and a front door to Lansdowne Village for locals and visitors. As a natural arrival area from the Lansdowne Canada Line station, it will be a new connection along the No. 3 Road retail and commercial corridor, and a signature highlight along the greenway emerging between the Olympic Oval Village and the Garden City Lands.

Centre Park

Location: Midway along the southern edge of the Lansdowne Centre property, ensuring access to sunlight.

Size: Approximately 2 hectares (5 acres), which is similar in size to Aberdeen Neighbourhood Park or three soccer fields.

Objective: To become Richmond's premier purpose-built festival space for concerts and celebrations. Its everyday role will be a neighbourhood-serving green space for informal recreation and relaxation.

Linear Park

Location: Along Lansdowne Road, the entire south side of the Lansdowne Centre redevelopment property.

Size: Approximately 20 meters wide and 500 meters long. To compare, the width of the linear park will be around three times the width of a pickleball court. The length of the linear park will be around 22 times the length of a tennis court.

Objective: To serve as the City Centre's central hub for civic events and a key catalyst for vibrant urban life. A unique 1.8 kilometer network of parks, amenities and institutions that creatively links Richmond's River, City and Fields.

Neighbourhood Plaza

Location: The northeast corner of Kwantlen Street and Lansdowne Road.

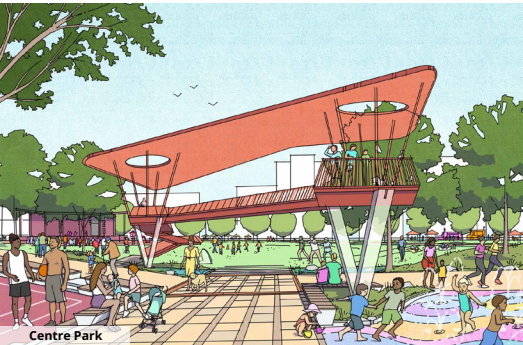
Size: Approximately 0.2 hectares (0.5 acres), which is similar in size to four pickleball courts or two tennis courts.

Objective: To become an intimate garden space where locals can gather, socialize, and seek respite.

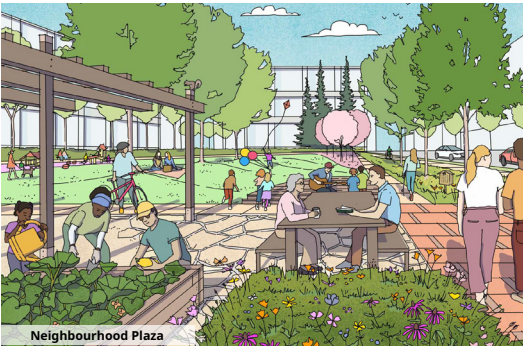
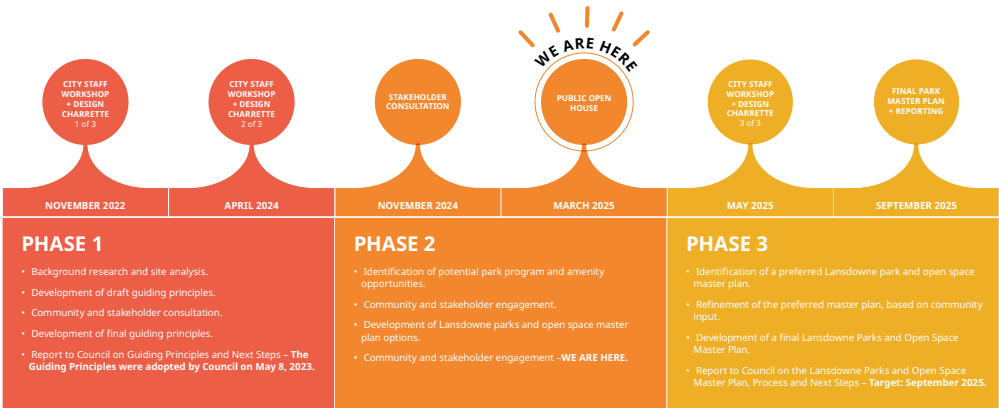
